Halloween Nude Cruise

Grab your costumes and sun gear and get ready for a preview of Halloween in Lahaina on our 7th Annual Halloween Nude Cruise. We have chartered the Mahana Naia which sails from Slip 47 in Maalaea Harbor. This is 4 slips toward Buzz's Wharf from the Maui Magic. The cruise will be on Sunday Oct 28 and will leave



at 10 AM and return at 1 PM. There will be food and drink on the boat so cruisers do not have to bring any. The Mahana Naia is a 60-foot catamaran that has a lot of deck space. It is licensed for 68 passengers but we will limit our cruise to 55.

For those of you who want to wear a costume or who want to fine-tune one for Lahaina, please do. We will try to have a formal viewing with all the cruisers passing judgement on the costumes.

Our cost for the boat and food will be the same as for the Valentine's cruise so we will keep our prices the same also: \$50 per FOLB member (no couple discount) and \$55 for non-members. So tell all your Little Beach friends about the cruise and prepare to have a great time.☆☆

Beach Beat / Local Update

A small (3-4 ft) shark (probably a white-tip Reef Shark) swam past LB on Friday July 7. It was about 30 ft out from the shore. Swimmers left the water as the shark lazily swam from North to South. After the shark rounded the rocks heading toward Big Beach, the LB swimmers re-entered the water and kept an eye out for a return swim-by. It did not return. Please visit our website for additional info. On Aug 16 a shark was sighted eating an Axis Deer just off Keawakapu Beach about 1:45 PM. DNLR closed beaches for about a mile on either side of the beach until the carcass could be removed. The beaches were re-opened around 3:30 PM.

About a week later, Glenn James showed a picture of an Axis Deer swimming about 1.5 miles off the shore of one of the islands. A day fisherman managed to get the deer into his boat and take it ashore where he freed it. This could explain how a shark can find a deer to feed on in the water.

Maui's Little Beach made the news in USA Today and on the Jay Leno Show as the best beach to bare it all. The mention on Jay Leno prompted a local writer to do a story for The Maui Weekly which covered everything from visitor comments to Sunday Fire Circle to comments on the legality of nudity on LB.
